REFLECT ON: Psalm 102

PRAISE GOD: For his unchanging nature—no matter what happens to us or to the world around us, God remains the same

OFFER THANKS: That our creator is perfect—nothing could be added to or subtracted from to improve his nature

CONFESS: Any tendency to place God on your own level, as though he is subject to the same laws and limitations of creation as you are

ASK GOD: To help you perceive his greatness more fully so that you will stop projecting your own feelings and judgements on him
